# Culture Course

Our culture course is the foundation of CultureBound, designed to equip you with an intercultural mindset, attitude, skills, and knowledge for effective communication and fruitful relationships.

### Structure

**Online Coursework:** You will have access to our learning site and complete all the online content by watching the videos and responding to the discussion questions.

**Fieldtrips:** As part of the training, you will take self-guided field trips on days 2, 3, and 4. Field trips are designed to give you experience applying the learning tools in real situations. Trainers will give you more instructions on how to plan for your field trips during the live sessions.

**Live Sessions:** You will have Zoom calls with our trainers. Our normal schedule for live sessions is 7-9 PM (Eastern Time) Monday-Thursday and 1-3 PM (Eastern Time) on Friday. We occasionally change our session schedules depending on the group. We will confirm with you as we get closer to the training. During these live meetings, we discuss your field trips together and review the online content for each day.
